

Rules – Season 2019/2020

General Rules

Practice:

Practice will be held in groups. The number of practice rounds depends on the number of participants. All practice heats will be done as controlled practice (8 min counting the 3 fastest consecutive laps). On the result of the controlled practice the qualification heats will be set. If there is more than one round of controlled practice, the best result of each driver will be counted for the reseeding.

Qualification:

In all classes there will be 3 or 4 rounds of qualifying. The qualifying heats will be held on Saturday and Sunday (two-day event). The number of qualifying rounds will be decided by the race director and depend on the number of participants. The qualifying will be counted by the EFRA Point-System (1 out of 3 or 2 out of 4). Each qualifying heat will be 8 min.

Finals:

Finals will be held in the “Heart of America”-Mode. In all classes there will be 3 finals, also the sub-finals. The finals will be counted by the EFRA Point-System (2 out of 3). Each finals heat will be 8 min.

Season Championship:

In total there will be 4 races. The race results will be counted by the known EFRA Points-System (1. = 155 points, 2. = 153 points, 3. = 152 points, and so on). TQ gives you 1 extra-point. Three out of the 4 races will be counted for the Season Championship.

Double start:

Double start is allowed.

Marshalling:

To do your marshalling is a matter of honor. A repeated missing of marshalling can be penalized in accordance to the decision of the race director.

Registration and Registration Fee:

The registration is to be made via myRCM. The Registration Fee (Saturday and Sunday) is 27 € for the first class for adults and 8 for adolescents until 18 years. For each following class (double start) it is 15 € for adults and 5 € for adolescents until 18 years. The “After-Registration Fee” is 5 €.

Starting numbers:

When registering to his first race, every participant gets his own personal starting number (per class), which he will keep the whole season. In the following season the starting number will be given based on the result of the last season championship.

Qualification for the German Nationals:

The races of the Arena 1/12 League which are held by the MAC Andernach (Arena 33) are counted as a race of the DMC West and Central Division Championship.

All participants will get points automatically for the national ranking list of the DMC in the classes EA/EB/EC and are qualified for the German Nationals in their class.

The participation in the German Nationals requires a valid license of the DMC.

For the DMC West or respectively Central Division Championship only drivers will be counted, who have a valid DMC license in the classes EA/EB/EC and are member of a club of the DMC West or Central Division.

Data Protection

Consent for the use of personal images

By participating in the public events (Arena 1/12 League), the driver or his legal representative agrees to the preparation, use and publication of photos and videos of his person. The consent applies to photos and videos for publication and dissemination in publications of the host or the organizer and for publication in print media, television as well as on websites and in social media of the host and the organizer, and by appointed media representatives. The granting of rights takes place without remuneration and includes the right to process, as far as the processing is not disfiguring. The consent is revocable at any time in the future for individual illustrations. In the case of multi-person portraits, the consent is irrevocable, unless a balance of interests is clearly in favor of the driver.

Consent to the publication of race results

By participating in the public events (Arena 1/12 League), the driver or the legal representative agrees to the publication of race results of his person. The consent applies to the publications in the publications of the host or the organizer for publication in print media, radio, television, on the Internet on the website of the host, the organizer, on myRCM.ch as well as in social media and commissioned media representatives.
