Revival 2021 is a vintage off-road RC racing festival for the **Parkinson's UK** charity and will take place across the weekend of Friday 31st July to Sunday 1st August at **Bingham Model Raceway** in Saxondale, Nottinghamshire, UK.

Entry fees

• £12 per buggy class per day to be paid once invoiced with PayPal. Maximum of one class entry per day.

Entrants will be PayPal invoiced over email by BMR in **June**. A percentage of the event's entry fees will go to **Parkinson's UK** along with the fundraising from a number of initiatives including raffles and online competitions.

Online Entry

Entry will open for **48 hours** at **12:00** (Midday) **Friday 19th February** to **12:00** (Midday) **Sunday 21st February**. The URL for the entry forms will be provided on the Facebook Event page a couple of days in advance. Entrants will be emailed during the following week to be advised if their entry is successful or whether they are on a reserve list.

BRCA

BRCA membership is a requirement. The Licence costs £20 per annum and runs from December to December. It can be purchased online from: https://www.brca.org/

Social Distancing Requirements

These are the requirements dated 1st January 2021. If they change, we will update all entrants.

Pitting will be socially distanced and an area per racer will be marked out. Anyone wishing to camp overnight must pre-register with John Weston. Details on the Camping registration will be sent out separately. Racers will need to advise in advance if they are part of a household and/or social bubble.

Racers must provide:

- A Hi-Viz Waistcoat for Marshalling.
- A pair of Gloves for Marshalling that are suitable for working in (not latex disposable).
- Face Masks to be worn at all times except when in an enclosed vehicle or pit tent.
- Hand Sanitiser.

Highly recommended to have available:

- A Face Shield.
- Some disposable latex gloves.
- Surface Cleaner.
- Hand Wipes.

Iconic Off-Road Rules

There are six Iconic 2WD classes and four Iconic 4WD classes.

We recommend keeping your buggy standard to what was seen racing back in the day. If you're concerned about your buggy's eligibility, contact John Weston <u>well before the event</u> and the Iconic team will assess it. Assessors will first consider whether this was <u>commonly seen racing</u> back during the year span of the class.

- 1. Electrics, shocks, slippers, wheels and tyres are open.
- 2. 2s LiPo limit.
- 3. Re-released buggies, such as the recent models from Tamiya, Team Associated, Kyosho and Schumacher are eligible in their original release category. Hop-ups for those buggies from their manufacturer are also eligible with the exception of the belt drive for the Kyosho Optima, Turbo Optima and Javelin. Please note that the Tamiya DT-02 Holiday Buggy 2010 and Sand Rover 2011 are not eligible because they have a modern chassis base.
- 4. Maximum buggy width is 250mm. There will be a box that the buggies (not the 2WD truck class) will need to fit into.
- 5. In 2WD, transmission orientation/motor position must be the same as the original factory production kit.
- 6. If you enter into the earliest 2WD Class, 77-82, you'll be contacted to determine whether your buggy is Standard or Modified. Within that class, there will be awards for Standard and for Modified buggies. Modifications must reflect those made in the day.
- 7. With the exception of the 2WD 77-82 class, modifications and customisations must be minimal. Any customisation and materials must match those **commonly seen racing** during the years of that buggy's class. For example, a modified Tamiya Hotshot chassis and materials must match those seen up to 1986.
- 8. We don't expect entrants to run newer parts (for example; arms) on an older buggy. If a buggy does have newer <u>vintage</u> parts then it should be entered into a later class. We do not want to see modern parts on vintage buggies. 'Homemade' and 3D printed parts <u>must match the original item</u>.

If a buggy doesn't meet with the rules, then report it at the event. There will be a **Scrutineer** at Revival 2021. If a buggy is ineligible we will do our best to help the entrant make it eligible. If we cannot make the buggy eligible then its time will not be recorded. Please consider this when preparing your entry because the best solution all round is to keep it standard to what you'd have seen racing back in the original year.

When you arrive

Please book in ASAP at Race Control. You will keep the same buggy number throughout the weekend.

Camping

Complimentary onsite camping is available. You do not need to register to camp. Camping is available overnight on Friday and Saturday only. Just arrive and you'll be directed past the track to a plot. The ground is soft (grass). There is no power and no lighting provided but there is a water tap. There will be Portaloos on site.

Pit Shop

Racecraft R/C will have a Pit Shop on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.



Food

Feast Streat will be onsite serving hot food on Friday from 14:00, Saturday and Sunday from 07:30.



Transponders

You will need a transponder to race at the Revival. BMR use a MYLAPS RC4 Decoder. The Purcy transponder will work but the older MRT's won't. All MYLAPS/AMB transponders will work. All newer MRT's that flash first will work. More help: https://youtu.be/SiQC_P72sfk

Batteries

You will need to provide your own source of power for recharging of batteries. Generators may be used but please try to position them so they are out of harm's way and so they are not an annoyance to other people attending the meeting. Please charge LiPo's in a fire sack.

Radio

Please consider using GHz radio for an easier day. If you are running MHz radio, please state which crystals you have when you register online so they can be put into the race computer.

Qualifying Heats

There will be 4 Rounds of staggered start 5-minute Qualifying Heats for each class. Racers must remain on the rostrum until the end of the heat.

Marshalling

All drivers must Marshall the heat immediately after their own heat.

Finals

The driver's best 2 heat times out of the 4 will determine grid position in the final. There may be A, B, C etc finals per class depending on entry levels. Racers must remain on the rostrum until the end of the final.

Race of Champions

The top 2 drivers from each A-Final (top 1 from 2WD 77-82) enter into the prestigious Race of Champions. This will see all classes, except the Truck class, fighting it out on track at the same time from a staggered start. The winner of the Race of Champions is crowned the event champion. There will be a 2WD Champion and a 4WD Champion.

Parkinson's UK Charity Raffle

There will be online raffles with some prizes to be collected at the event.

Icon of the Day Award

This award will go to the most stand-out or unique buggy racing on each day.

The Brett Davis Newcomer Award

This special trophy will be presented on each day to who we feel made the best Revival debut.

The Schumacher Racing Daniel Rowlands Revival Veteran Award 2021



This special award, presented on Sunday lunchtime, will go to an entrant who has made a notable contribution to the Revivals over the years.
